



May 10 and 11 of next year has been scheduled as Rainbow Flowage Clean Up. We hope to see as many of you as possible there. As I'm on the subject of Rainbow Flowage, it was voted on at the recently concluded Grande Promenade that the Amish up by Whitehall will be constructing new windows with vinyl sills for the pavilion. We will be doing the installing ourselves. Cost is approximately \$3,900.

The Grande Promenade hosted by Jefferson County #750 was by all standards a success. National Membership Directeur "Gena Keller" gave a very inspirational speech at the Saturday evening banquet about La Societe. We thank her for all she does in promoting membership and the programs of La Societe. Due to health and timing, we had to vote on three different Grande Voiture Delegates to the National Promenade. 

On August 25, Zablocki held their annual Baby Shower event where the Voluntary Services presented needed items to Veteran mothers of newborn or are expecting a new arrival in their families. Through the "Keep the Wheelchairs Rolling "campaign I was able acquire \$400.00 to help for this event.

Our Grande Promenade in Fort Atkinson was a great time as always. Thank You to Jefferson County 750 for hosting this event. I want also thank my escorts Voyageurs Winger and Austin for escorting me to Grand Chef de Gare Passe Luncheon during our Grande Promenade. I never felt safer. Here is your reminder that if your Locale's finances are based on the fiscal year, you have until November 15 to file your IRS form 990 or 990EZ. It is very simple to do the 990EZ online, provided the person trying to do so, has the Voiture Employer Identification Number (EIN). If that number seems to elude you locally, your Grand Commissaire Intendant should be able to assist

you in that matter. Please don't let yourself fall out of good graces with the IRS.

I feel it best to point out once again that our tax exempt status pertains ONLY to income tax. There is not a veteran's service organization in Wisconsin incorporated as a 501(C)19 entity, which covers our Posts and Voitures, that is exempt from Wisconsin state sales tax. Lest there be any doubt, we are required to pay state sales tax on our purchases for the Voitures.

At the Grand Promenade in Fort Atkinson, the audit committee went over the checkbook, receipts, investments, and bank statements. Everything was found to be in order. I would like to thank them and the Finance Committee for the involvement during the past fiscal year.

Our investments past fiscal year did fairly well. As of the end of June, we have a moderate gain on our portfolio. We did withdraw from our investment this past fiscal year to replenish the checkbook and for the purchase of the new tractor at Camp American Legion. Next year, it was voted on to replace the windows in the pavilion at the Rainbow Flowage. John Aasen got a real good price from the Amish community. We will probably install these during the Spring cleanup in May. Membership dues should provide the largest source of income to the Grand Voiture, but that share has decreased over the years. Please do not allow your Voiture to become stagnant by not recruiting new members to overcome our losses. These are the Voitures that come to the point of having just a few elderly voyageurs, no longer able to function as a unit, and are forced to turn in their charter. We need fresh younger blood to remain vibrant and grow. Believe it or not, they are out there. We just need to seek them out and invite them to join this great organization. All of the financial information for the past fiscal year and next year's recommended budget were available at the Grande Promenade in Fort Atkinson in August. If you need a copy of them, please let me know and I will send them to you by email. Also, all of our tax information has been sent to an accounting firm to be made out and filed. In closing, I hope everyone stays healthy this coming year. Hope to see many of you at future events. Be sure to keep our troops in your prayer.




Please encourage your Locales to purchase these Pins. Send me an email or give me a call to place your order, I will get them in the mail to you right away.

If your Locale has assisted a family; be sure to include Voiture Locale & County, number of children affected, nature of event, and how much money was spent.


Please remember if you use the Ardery Fund the money that is reimbursed to your locale does not go on your yearly reports.

Thank you for trusting me to serve as your Grande Presidente this year. It will be my second go-round at doing this job, having held the position in 2020-21.




